PLEASE NOTE:

Where a person is or would be, if he were a qualified voter, entitled to apply for the right to vote by absentee ballot under the provisions of law*, his spouse, parent or child, if a qualified voter and a resident of the same school district, shall be entitled to vote as an absentee voter upon personally making and signing an application in accordance with the provisions of law and showing that he expects to be absent from the school district on the day of the school district election by reason of accompanying or being with the spouse, child or parent who is or would be, if he were a qualified voter, so entitled to apply for the right to vote by absentee ballot, and, in the event no application is made by such spouse, child or parent, such further information as the clerk of the school district or designee of the trustees or school board shall require.

This application must be delivered to the District Clerk or Designee of the School Board at least seven (7) days before the election if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter (May 14, 2024) or the day before the election (May 20, 2024) if the ballot is to be personally delivered to the voter.

If the School District Clerk finds the application meets all of the required criteria and is satisfied the applicant is a qualified voter of the district, and entitled to vote by absentee ballot, the Clerk shall issue an absentee ballot. Ballots may be mailed or delivered in person only directly to applicants. Applicants may not designate another individual to receive the ballot on their behalf.
